Purchase Agreement/Health Guarantee

Thank you for deciding to purchase one of our puppies! We want to make this a stress-free enjoyable experience for you. Please feel free to email us with any questions or concerns that you might have along the way.

This contract is written for the protection of both the breeder and the buyer - However, it is primarily written to protect the health and general wellbeing of the puppy.

Purchase Agreement

1. Please read the health guarantee completely before putting a deposit on a puppy. **By putting a deposit on a puppy, you are agreeing to the terms and conditions within this contract.**
2. We require a \$500, non-refundable, deposit in order to hold the puppy of your choice. The deposit can only be made on our website, or in the form of PayPal (plus PayPal fees) or cash.
3. This deposit is non-refundable, unless there is a problem with the health of your puppy. In that case, the buyer will have their choice of a full refund or of transferring that deposit toward another puppy.

****Please be certain that you are ready for the time commitment and financial**

Responsibility of a puppy prior to putting a deposit on one. **

Health Guarantee

1. It will be up to us, the breeders, to decide when the puppy will be ready to go to its new home. Usually at the age of 8 weeks, depending on the breed, weight of the puppy, and how easily it is weaned from the mother. We will not, under any circumstances, let the puppy leave before it is ready. There is an additional \$10 a day charge for puppies held for a latter delivery/pickup once ready to go home
2. Buyer understands that Seller's prediction of coat type, hypo allergenic fur, height, or weight at adulthood are estimates only.
3. The puppy is guaranteed to be in good health at the time of sale. Your puppy is guaranteed against fatal viruses for 72 hours. This includes Distemper, Parvo, and Corona. Not covered are Coccidiosis and Giardia, because they are commonly found in puppies and may or may not cause symptoms. Stress of new home and new surroundings can trigger a stress-related outbreak.
4. The puppy will be up to date on shots and deworming at the time of pickup/delivery of the puppy. It is very important that you continue the vaccinations and deworming. Please do not expose your puppy to other dogs that are not vaccinated until he/she has completed the entire vaccination schedule - around 16-20 weeks old. Discuss this with your Vet for your specific pup.
5. The puppy will have been vet checked, and deemed in good health at the time of sale.
6. The buyer, at their own expense, should have the puppy examined by a Licensed Vet within **5 days** of receiving the puppy. Failure to have puppy examined within 5 days voids the health guarantee.

7. Documentation must be sent to the breeder within ten days in order for the Health Guarantee to be honored.
8. This guarantee does not cover any health issues caused by neglect or injury from the buyer.
9. This guarantee does not include minor illnesses and health issues such as colds, allergies, internal or external parasites or umbilical hernias. However, the breeder will disclose any known illnesses or health issues prior to the sale.
10. The breeder cannot assume responsibility for this puppy after **72 hours** of the sale. It is the responsibility of the buyer to care for the puppy properly and keep it free from harm. Please remember that your puppy must be treated with great care and protected from danger.
11. The breeder assumes no responsibility for any medical expenses incurred after the sale.
12. The breeder assumes no responsibility for training difficulties or behavior problems. We strongly advise all new owners to attend puppy kindergarten, obedience classes, and/or hire a private trainer.
13. The breeder does not guarantee size. We will give the buyer the weight of the puppy's parents. We can give the buyer an educated guess as to full grown weight, but there are too many variables besides genetics.
14. Spay or neuter of the puppy must be performed by (7) seven months of age, or health guarantee is void. The puppy is strictly sold as a quality pet.
15. The breeder is not responsible for puppies which develop Hypoglycemia after the puppy is in the new owner's possession.
16. The breeder gives a one-year guarantee against any life threatening congenital or hereditary defects of the puppy. This will need to be addressed in writing by a licensed Vet and confirmed by a Vet of Teddy and Graham Doodles choosing. If this should occur then the puppy will be returned to the breeder, and the buyer will receive another puppy of the same breed and value when there is one available. This guarantee does not cover cosmetic defects.
17. If for any reason I am unable to keep the puppy, I agree to return the puppy to Teddy and Graham Doodles and not place the puppy in a shelter. If puppy is returned within the first **30 days**, only half of the purchase price will be refunded after the puppy has been placed in his/her new home. The other half will cover the cost of re-advertisement and keeping the puppy current on vaccinations and deworming until the puppy is placed in his/her new home. If puppy is returned after the 30 days no money will be refunded.
